<b>SHB 1628</b>	<b>Real estate excise tax</b>		
CAPR Recommends <b>DO NOT PASS</b>	CAPR rating = -10 (Poor)	Impact is Limited	
Adds a new state real estate excise tax threshold of \$5,000,000 on January 1, 2025, with the portion of the selling price that is above the threshold taxed at a rate of 4 percent. Provides for the distribution of the increase in revenue from the new threshold over what would have been collected had the new threshold not been imposed, including to a newly created Developmental Disabilities Trust Account that can be used for housing support for individuals with developmental disabilities. Allows a county or city to impose an additional 0.25 percent real estate excise tax for the construction and support of affordable housing beginning January 1, 2024. Removes the expiration date on the ability to use certain local government real estate excise tax funds for facilities for those experiencing homelessness or for affordable housing, and removes a \$1,000,000 limit on the annual use of such funds in larger jurisdictions. Removes certain restrictions on the permitted uses of revenue from specified local government real estate excise taxes, and allows for the councilmanic imposition of a 0.25 percent real estate excise tax by counties, and cities within those counties, that choose to plan under the Growth Management Act instead of requiring voter approval. Creates a real estate excise tax exemption for certain sales or transfers of properties that qualify for a property tax exemption that will be used for a community purpose.

Allows a county legislative authority to hold regular meetings once per calendar month in a city within the county that has a greater population than the county seat, and once per quarter at any other location within the county, provided that no more than one meeting per month is held at an alternative location.

## SHB 1789 Ecosystem services

CAPR Recommends **DO NOT PASS** CAPR rating = -10 (Poor) Impact is Serious

Authorizes the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to enter into contracts for ecosystem services projects to generate revenue by providing ecosystem services that directly or indirectly benefit humans or enhance social welfare.Provides that ecosystem services projects must result in no-net decrease in agricultural production for agricultural lands, nor in the decadal sustainable harvest volume and operable forestland acres on state lands and state forestlands within the sustainable harvest unit.Provides that ecosystem services projects must result in a net increase in future sustainable harvest volume on forested state trust lands within the sustainable harvest unit.Provides that any payment for an ecosystem services project, contract, or agreement may not limit or impair the exercise of tribal treaty and reserved rights, existing tribal access to lands managed by the DNR, or preexisting agreements between tribes and the DNR.Requires the Board of Natural Resources to approve contract terms and minimum payment for ecosystem services before entering into a contract.Requires the DNR to report to the Legislature and the Office of Financial Management by December 1, 2024, on ecosystem services projects.

## HB 1832 Vehicle per mile charge

Establishes a voluntary Road Usage Charge Program (RUC Program) beginning July 1, 2025, which places a 2.5 cent per mile fee on motor vehicle usage of public roadways in the state. Waives the electric and hybrid-electric vehicle registration renewal fees and the transportation electrification fees for vehicles participating in the voluntary RUC Program. Limits the total per-mile fee for electric and hybrid-electric vehicles to the combined amount of electric and hybrid-electric vehicle registration renewal and transportation electrification fees that would otherwise be due if they had not been waived.Reduces the annual per-mile fee by a fee credit in the amount of the motor vehicle fuel tax that is determined by the Department of Licensing, either constructively or actually, to correspond to a participating vehicle's annual motor vehicle fuel usage. Requires that the Washington State Transportation Commission pursue federal grant funding opportunities for which the RUC Program is eligible.Mandates that proceeds from the RUC Program be used for transportation system preservation and maintenance purposes.Sets January 1, 2030 as the target date for implementation of a comprehensive, mandatory RUC Program.

Requires the Department of Transportation to establish a competitive grant program to help finance qualifying housing projects within rapid transit corridors, and to provide technical assistance for implementing, and compliance review of, transit-oriented development regulations.Establishes that cities planning under the Growth Management Act (GMA) may not enact or enforce any new development regulation within a transit station area that prohibits the siting of multifamily residential housing on parcels where any other residential use is permissible.Establishes that cities planning under the GMA may not enact any new development regulation within a transit station area or hub that imposes a maximum floor area ratio of less than the applicable transit-oriented density for any use otherwise permitted, or imposes a maximum residential density, measured in residential units per acre or other metric of land area.Prohibits counties and cities planning under the GMA from requiring off-street parking as a condition of permitting development within a transit station area, with exceptions.Expands the categorical exemption for infill development to facilitate the timely and certain deployment of sustainable transit-oriented development.

Authorizes the Utilities and Transportation Commission to regulate the rates and services of all persons engaging within the state in the business of acting as a landlord for mobile home parks, manufactured housing communities, or manufactured/mobile home communities. Prohibits, with limited exceptions, a landlord from increasing the rent for a tenancy subject to the Manufactured/Mobile Home Landlord-Tenant Act in an amount greater than the rate of inflation as measured by the consumer price index. Makes a landlord who charges and collects rent in excess of permitted amounts, liable to the tenant for an amount not to exceed \$100,000.

## SHB 1378 Derelict aquatic structures

CAPR Recommends **DO NOT PASS** CAPR rating = -1 (Lacking) Impact is Little

Authorizes the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to purchase or otherwise acquire lands and facilities related to derelict aquatic structures, and to remove, refurbish, or dispose of derelict aquatic structures.Requires the DNR to submit all derelict aquatic structure removal projects to a mitigation credits program in order to generate conservation credits, and requires any payments received for the sale of credits to be deposited into the Derelict Structure Removal Account created in the bill.Creates the Derelict Structure Removal Account.Directs the DNR to establish a grant program for lessees of state-owned aquatic land who need financial assistance to comply with the DNR's habitat stewardship measures for the construction and maintenance of aquatic structures.Authorizes the DNR to acquire aquatic structures that do not meet the definition of derelict aquatic structures, but that could provide habitat benefits or amenities for the local community if the structure was refurbished or repurposed.

## 2SHB 1578 Wildland fire safety

Requires the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to complete decadal assessments of areas at significant risk of wildfire, beginning with the decade between July 1, 2025, and July 1, 2035. Requires the DNR to cooperate with and provide support to various local entities to develop public safety evacuation strategies for incorporation into local emergency response plans. Requires the DNR to take certain actions to expand its community resilience programming and associated supporting programs within the wildland urban interface in areas of Western Washington where the DNR determines that risk of wildfires and smoke exposure exist. Requires the DNR to implement a Post-Wildfire Debris Flow Program by July 1, 2024, and establish a structure for a state-sponsored burned area emergency stabilization and response team by December 30, 2024.

## 2SHB 1580 Children in crisis

Requires that the Governor maintain a Children and Youth Multisystem Care Coordinator (Care Coordinator) to serve as a state lead on addressing complex cases of children in crisis. Requires that the Care Coordinator, in coordination with the Department of Children, Youth, and Families; the Health Care Authority; the Office of Financial Management; and the Department of Social and Health Services, develop and implement a Rapid Care Team for the purpose of supporting and identifying appropriate services and living arrangements for a child in crisis, and that child's family, if appropriate. Allows the Care Coordinator to have access to flexible funds to support the safe discharge of children in crisis from hospitals and long-term, appropriate placement for children in crisis who are dependent.

## SHB 1677 Campaign finance disclosure

Requires political and incidental committees formed after the first day of the last full month before an election, rather than the last three weeks, to file statements of organization within three business days of organization. Requires candidates and political and incidental committees to file an additional contributions and expenditures report 34 days before a general election. Increases the threshold for contributions to trigger a special report from \$1,000 to be tied to the contribution limit for state officers, which is currently \$2,000, and increases the special reporting period for large contributions from 21 days before an election to the beginning of the last full month before an election. Requires purchasers of political advertising or electioneering communications to disclose to commercial advertisers that the purchase includes political advertising or electioneering communications, upon request of the commercial advertiser. Makes the Public Disclosure Transparency Account a nonappropriated account, and establishes purposes for which it may be spent.
